Family Devotional

Day 1: Read Psalm 126:1-2a (until the semicolon)

- 1) Sometimes we are so happy we can hardly believe it is true! What is something God did for you that made you so happy you thought you were dreaming?
- 2) What did you do when that happened? Did you laugh or dance or jump up and down? Did you know that we can worship God even by laughing and shouting with joy?
- 3) Sing this week's song together, remembering the way that God made you full of joy!

Day 2: Read Psalm 126:2b

- 1) Sometimes, when God does great things for us, other people notice, too!
- 2) Think of your friends and family. What is one good thing God did for someone else that also made you happy? Praise God together for the way He does good things for other people!

Day 3: Read Psalm 126:3

- 1) When God does great things for us, we are glad! It is so true!
- 2) What are some other things that God has done for you or your family? Make a list together of good things that God has done for you all!
- 3) Now celebrate together with a worship party! Praise God for all of these wonderful things that He has done for you! You could sing this week's song again, if you would like!

Day 4: Read Psalm 126:5-6

- 1) Life isn't always happy. Sometimes sad things happen. But the Bible promises that sadness doesn't last forever. Later we will have joy again!
- 2) Can you remember a time for you that started sad but then became happy later? Remind each other of ways that God blessed you and your family with joy after a hard time.
- 3) What is one thing that you can do to remember in the future that God does not let sad days continue forever – that He brings joyful days to us after the sad days? Go ahead and make that reminder together now!
