3. What is the difference between pursuing righteousness by faith and pursuing righteousness by works?
4. Why do you think people naturally want to prove themselves worthy before God?
5. Romans 10:4 says Christ is the culmination/end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes; what does this mean?
6. Romans 10:17 says, “Faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.” What does this teach us about the relationship between Scripture, hearing, and faith?
7. Why do you think some people hear the gospel but still refuse to believe?

1. Who in my life may need to hear the gospel from me?
2. What keeps me from sharing my faith more openly?
3. When was the last time I intentionally told someone about what Jesus has done for me?
4. Am I praying for opportunities to help others hear the gospel?
